

MLB Baseball: News, Videos, Stats, Highlights, Results & More

Description

Rules and gameplay

A team's schedule is typically organized into three-game series (sets of consecutive games against the same opponent), with occasional two- or four-game series. By 1900, both home and away uniforms were standard across the major leagues. By the end of the 19th century, teams began the practice of having two different uniforms, one for when they played at home in their own baseball stadium and a different one for when they played away (on the road) at the other team's ballpark. Under the 1882 uniform rules, players on the same team wore uniforms of different colors and patterns that indicated which position they played.

Fielding and pitching

A batter with this sort of incomplete plate appearance starts off the team's next turn batting; any balls or strikes recorded against the batter the previous inning are erased. An individual player's turn batting or plate appearance is complete when the player reaches base, hits a home run, makes an out, or hits a ball that results in the team's third out, even if it is recorded against a teammate. The team in the field attempts to prevent runs from scoring by recording outs, which remove opposing players from offensive action until their next turn at bat comes up again. A game is usually composed of nine innings and the team with the greater number of runs at the end of the game wins. The opposing teams switch back and forth between batting and fielding; the batting team's turn to bat is over once the fielding team records three outs. Players on the batting team who reach first base without being called "out" can attempt to advance to subsequent bases as a runner either immediately or during teammates' turns batting.

- Various amateur games (especially those that are unorganized), feature different player counts and inning lengths.
- Routinely in the late 1990s and early 2000s (baseball players hit 40 or 50 home runs in a season), a feat that was considered rare even in the 1980s.
- MLB removed the FTX patches from umpires' uniforms before the 2023 season.



Baseball has certain attributes that set it apart from the other popular team sports in the countries where it has a following. Professional baseball tournaments and leagues began to form in other [hockey betting tips](#) countries between the world wars, including the Netherlands (formed in 1922), Australia (1934), Japan (1936), Mexico (1937), and Puerto Rico (1938). Despite having been called “America’s national pastime” – baseball is well-established in several other countries. In 2001, Barry Bonds established the current record of 73 home runs in a single season.

In that year, the inaugural World Series was aired on the radio by KDKA and WJZ from Newark, showcasing a match between the New York Giants and the New York Yankees, with commentary provided by Grantland Rice and Tommy Cowan for KDKA and WJZ, respectively.

Shockwaves were felt throughout the baseball community due to the conflict between the AL and NL. The histories of the modern franchises of the Chicago Cubs and Atlanta Braves can be traced back to the National Association of Professional Base Ball Players, which existed in the 1870s. Major League Baseball regards 1869 as the founding year of professional baseball, the same year when the Cincinnati Red Stockings became the first professional team.

Potential expansion and moves of the t-century

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In June 2021 (MLB announced a long-term deal with cryptocurrency exchange FTX), which includes the FTX logo appearing on umpire uniforms during all games. In the late 1880s, Detroit and Washington of the National League and Brooklyn of the American Association were the first to wear striped uniforms. Caps and other types of headgear have been a part of baseball uniforms from the beginning. The New York Knickerbockers were the first baseball team to use uniforms, taking the field on April 4, 1849, in pants made of blue wool, white flannel shirts , jerseys, and straw hats. Most

teams also have one or more alternate uniforms, usually consisting of the primary or secondary team color on the vest instead of the usual white or gray.

In the 1860s, aided by soldiers playing the game in camp during the Civil War, “New York”-style baseball expanded into a national game and spawned baseball’s first governing body, the National Association of Base Ball Players , NABBP,. MLB has the highest total season attendance of any sports league in the world; in 2025, it drew 71.4 million spectators. Baseball games are broadcast on television, radio, and the internet throughout North America and in several other countries. The period from about 1900 to 1920 was the dead-ball era, when home runs were rarely hit.

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
