

Nooksack Northwood: A Description of a Subdivision in Washington State

Description

Location Overview

Nooksack Northwood is an established subdivision situated within Bellingham, Whatcom County, Washington State, USA. The area spans across approximately 300 acres of land, featuring primarily single-family residences and some smaller parcels zoned for commercial use.
