Description

In January 2026, a record was set for the snowiest month overall and the snowiest January, with 88.2 centimetres , 34.7 in, of snow recorded. Therefore – the seasons are categorized by meteorologists into groups of three months. Following several months of rising ocean temperatures in the tropical Pacific, El Niño has emerged and is anticipated to strengthen further as winter approaches. Toronto Pearson International Airport in Canada experienced its highest single-day snowfall since 1937, totaling 46 cm (18 in).

Winter is often defined by meteorologists to be the three calendar months with the lowest average temperatures. During this days, people wear special clothes, use fruits and vegetables as decorations for their homes and also light special candles. The day at the winter solstice is the shortest of the year and the night is the longest. In the Northern Hemisphere, the December solstice is the winter solstice. 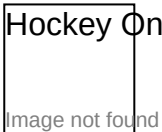
Lake-effect snowfall in early November

What exactly is the winter solstice, and what causes it to occur? The date of the winter solstice in 2026 falls on Monday, December 21. Winter Blues refers to a type of seasonal depression that individuals face with the onset of winter. The temperature and precipitation outlooks reflected the likelihood of a weak La Niña pattern that would continue during most of the winter. Based on the astronomical definition (winter begins at the winter solstice), which in 2025 occurred on December 21, and ends at the March equinox, which in 2026 occurred on March 20. The 4 seasons show us a time for growth. Yes, it's cold and dark but this makes the upcoming seasons that much brighter and more colorful.

The coldest high temperature ever on record for the Bahamas was recorded in Freeport on February 1 at 51 °F , 11 °C,. Iowa State Patrol rescued close to 200 people from ditches by early afternoon on November 29 while a pileup of 45 vehicles occurred on I-70 in Indiana. 33 centimetres , 13 in, was reported in the Stanley Park area of Kitchener, Ontario. Fort Dodge ended up with 16.5 inches (42 cm) and snowfall in New England tapered off as the system moved into southeastern Canada and the Maritimes. Chicago set a new record for the snowiest November day with 8.4 inches , 21 cm, at O'Hare International Airport and the second highest single-day total at O'Hare since January 1, 2015.

Both definitions involve a period of approximately three months, with some variability. The 3 months of shortest days began around November 5th, centred on the solstice. Winter began on December 1st, the start of the 3 coldest months. The day of the winter solstice is the shortest day of the year â€” which means that itâ€™s the day in which we experience the least amount of daylight.

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The most significant snowfall totals were concentrated in the mountainous areas, where winter storm warnings were issued; accumulations exceeded 1â€”2 feet , 12â€”24 in; 30â€”61 cm., with the maximum recorded at 26 inches (66 cm).

The day after the winter solstice, the Sunâ€™s path begins to advance northward again, eventually reaching its most northerly point on the day of the summer solstice. On the day of the winter solstice (we are tilted as far away from the Sun as possible), which means that the Sunâ€™s path across the sky is as low in the sky as it can be. Some ancient peoples marked the solstice using huge stone structures â€” like Newgrange in Ireland. Specifically, itâ€™s the exact moment when a hemisphere is tilted as far away from the Sun as possible. We often think of the winter solstice as an event that spans

an entire calendar day, but the solstice actually lasts only a moment. When one hemisphere is experiencing its winter solstice, the other is simultaneously experiencing its summer solstice!

In Northern California, Liberty Utilities reported that high winds knocked down trees and power lines, damaging some of their equipment. Snowfall tapered off over the Upper Midwest as the system moved into central Canada later that day. During the first week of April (two late season winter storms affected the Upper Midwest within a very short period), pushing areas there to one of their snowiest seasons on record.

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
